

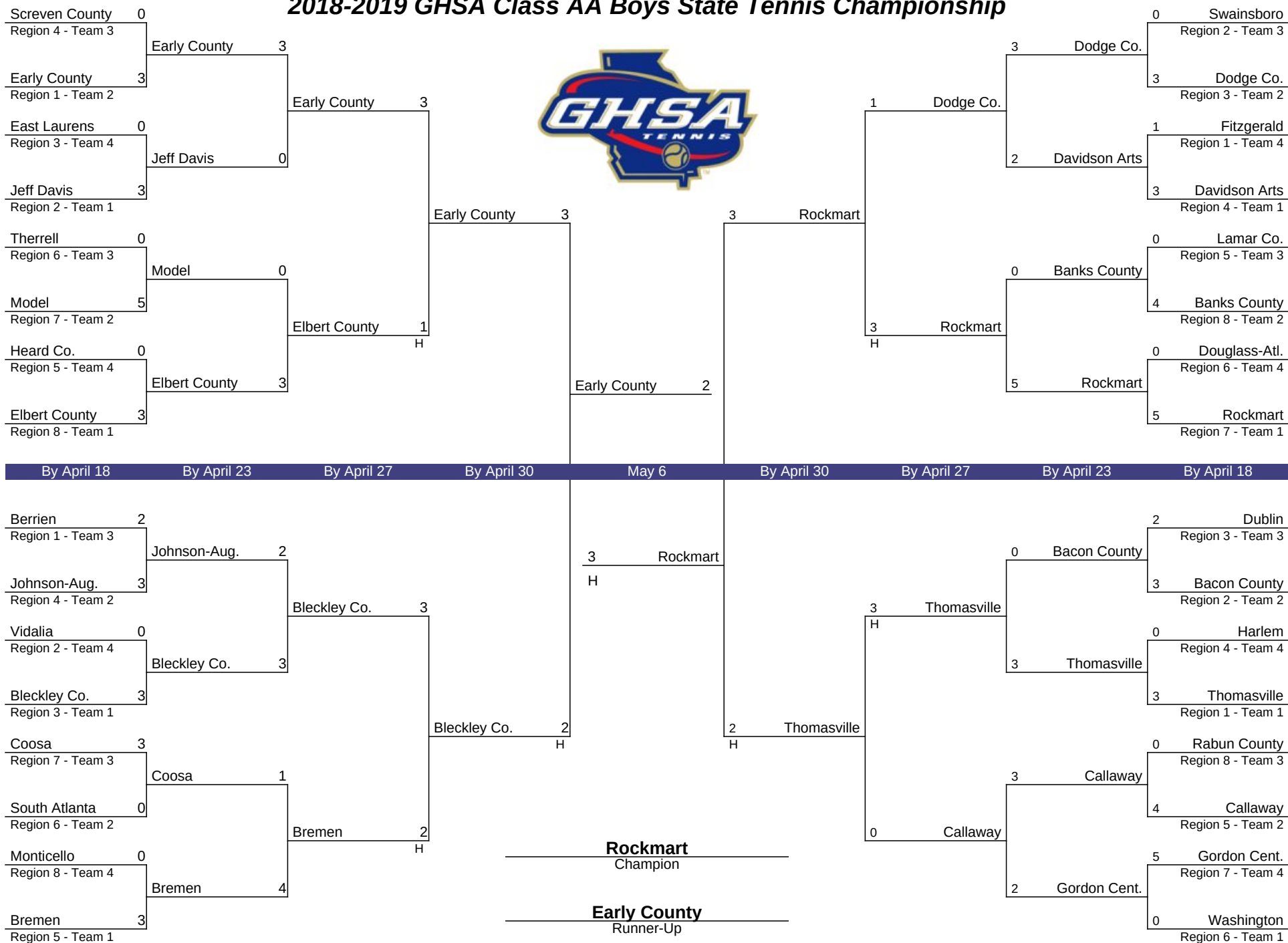

# 2018-2019 GHSA Class A Public Boys State Tennis Championship

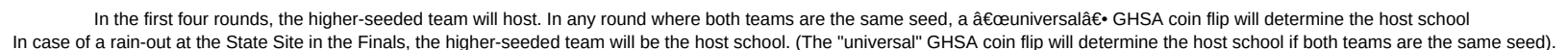


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# 2018-2019 GHSA Class AA Boys State Tennis Championship
