



CONGRATULATIONS ON YOUR ADVANCEMENT TO THE 2010  
GHSA STATE BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT  
QUARTER-FINALS AND FINALS

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY

1. Contact your respective "Site Coordinator" asap to confirm the date, time, and other pertinent information about your game and the site policies and procedures.
2. If you have not already done so, contact GA Sports to submit your team roster at [gasports.com](http://gasports.com)
3. Refer to pages 56 & 57 of the GHSA White Book to review the policies and procedures relevant to State Tournament games.
4. The officiating assignments have been made through the GHSA Office.
5. The admission price for the quarter-final, semi-final, and Championship games is \$10.00.
6. Each school shall submit the "Game Administrators Form" upon entry at the team entry gate.
7. Rosters and starting lineups must be submitted to the "official scorebook" no less than (15) minutes prior to game time.
8. The team on the lower part of the bracket will be designated as the HOME TEAM, and will wear white jerseys. The team on the upper part of the bracket will be designated as the VISITING TEAM, and will wear dark jerseys.
9. Teams playing the first game of the day may have access to the court no earlier than (30) minutes prior to game time.
10. Teams playing in subsequent games, may utilize the court during the halftime intermission of the previous game, but must clear the court when one or both teams return to the court.

## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR QUARTER-FINAL, SEMI-FINAL, AND FINAL GAMES**

A. Until eliminated from the state tournament within the respective classification, each team will be allowed free admission at the site in which they participate.

1. Coaches are admitted with their GHSA coaching pass and officials with their GAOA pass.
2. Each team will be allowed to list a maximum of twenty (20) individuals on the "Team Travel Form".
3. Each participating school will be allowed to admit a maximum of sixteen (16) uniformed cheerleaders.
4. Each school will be charged for additional personnel entering through the team entry gate.
5. A maximum of six (6) floor passes will be issued to each participating school for coaches and auxiliary personnel (managers, statisticians, trainers, etc.). Passes must be visible when in the court area. Additional official team staff must sit behind the bench in the team bench area.
6. Media personnel must have a visible "Media Pass" indicating the publication/station they represent. All working media must sign in on the Media Pass Check-In form.

B. Each school is responsible for the behavior of its coaches, players, and spectators at state tournament games.

Therefore, the behavior of these groups must be monitored by designated school administrators in the following areas:

1. No bands, artificial noise makers, banners/signs, radios or other music-producing devices are allowed.
2. Throwing of objects onto the floor will not be tolerated.
3. Spectators must wear shirts and shoes at all times.
4. Security personnel, and game officials, have the right to demand that unruly spectators be removed from the arena.
5. Spectators are NOT allowed on the playing court following the games. Violators may be prosecuted for "trespassing".

C. Each school is responsible for providing its own basketballs for warm-ups. Official game balls will be provided by the GHSA.

D. Each school is responsible for providing its own towels, water, gatorade, etc.

E. Print a copy of the following forms, complete them, and submit them at the time your team checks in at the game site. (Team Travel Form, Excess Team Entry Form, Media Check-In Form)
