**Substitute Motion** by Etheridge, second by Giddens to change the wording as follows: For the purposes of the 3% out-of-county rule ONLY, single-gender schools will have their number based on the actual percentage of students enrolled in that school from outside the county (before their enrollment is doubled for reclassification placement). **MOTION PASSED (unanimously)** (Note: This goes into effect for 2018-19 school year)
