NEW BUSINESS:

- Proposal** to reword By-Law 2.56 on page 28 of the GHSA Constitution as follows (old text is struck out, new text in italic):
~~A person who is an active official or an assignor of officials at the high school level may not be a head coach or an assistant coach at a GHSA school in the same sport. A head coach, or an assistant coach, at a GHSA member school may register and officiate a sport in which they coach with the following provisions:~~
(a) *May officiate a sub-varsity level contest at any GHSA member school.*
(b) *May officiate varsity level, and post-season level, games that do NOT involve schools in the same classification as the school at which they coach. (GHSA Office) **Effective Immediately.***
