The Board of Trustees held a called electronic meeting to consider the appeal by Brunswick High School, of 39 football players deemed suspended for leaving the sidelines and participation in a fight during a playoff football game with Brunswick on November 21, 2025. The two players ejected that were listed on the official's game report, were NOT appealed.

Call to order was made by BOT President Jim Finch and roll call was taken by Marvin James via zoom.

Michael Thompson made a motion to approve the agenda and Steve Simpson seconded, it was passed unanimously.

Brunswick District AD, Steve Waters, assisted by Principal Slade turner, presented the appeal for the BOT requesting the GHSA office to remain consistent with penalties toward Brunswick, as they have with Gainesville and earlier this season with Northeast and Southwest Macon (who had a similar bench clearing incident in their game back in August 2025.)

Curt Miller made a motion to overturn the ejection/suspension for all Brunswick players who were not listed as
ejected on the official's game report. The motion also included a change of probation status on the program to
severe warning. This punishment is consistent with how Gainesville, Northeast and Southwest Macon were
punished regarding the same; however, the monetary fines will remain. Scarlett Grantham seconded the
motion.
