**III. Region 8AA representatives presented a proposal to allow Regions in Classifications 2A-4A, which consist of both public and private schools, to determine both a private and public school region winner to qualify as Region Champion for purposes of seeding in their respective state tournament bracket.**

Motion to table made by Mike Thompson, Steve Simpson seconded.

**Motion Passes unanimously, 65-0.**

Classification Committee members from classifications 2A-4A will work with Don Corr and the GHSA office to better explain the proposal.

**IV. The GHSA office proposed a change as follows:**

**Winning Percentage (WP) to be calculated by taking a team's weighted wins divided by the number of actual contests played. Home win equals 0.9, away win equals 1.1, and neutral site win equals 1, and non-GHSA win equals 0.9. GHSA member schools may not win more than 20% of their scheduled contests against non-GHSA schools. All contests will count toward the minimum number of contests and any win beyond the 20% maximum will be counted as no contest.**

Motion to approve but to change all home, away, and neutral sites to 1.0, with non-GHSA wins equal to 0.9 by Eli Connell, seconded by Steve Waters.

**Motion Passes unanimously, 65-0.**

**V. GHSA office proposed officiating game fees for the 2026-28 reclass cycle (See attached schedule).**

Motion to approve was made by Jesse Crews and seconded by Brian Montgomery.

**Motion Passes unanimously, 65-0.**

**VI. Executive Director report**

Dr. Tim Scott apologized to the Committee for the Gainesville and Brunswick fight incident because the GHSA office did not apply the same penalty for ejecting players in a similar incident that happened earlier this season. Moving forward the GHSA will strengthen its By-Laws to ensure the GHSA consistently addresses fight situations. Associate

Director, Jay Russell, also apologized to the committee and took responsibility for the error.

**VII. Gainesville HS appeal of ejections in the Brunswick game.**

Motion to reverse these ejections in light of the GHSA's inconsistent enforcement of post-game ejections in previous similar game situations made by Jesse Crews and seconded by Rendell Jackson.

**TRAVEL FEES: (1) Official \$30.00 (2) Officials \$40.00 (3) Officials \$50.00 (4+) Officials Add \$7.00 Per Official**

Travel Fees are based on a "per crew/per competition day" basis. Regular season travel fees for travel of more than 100 miles are doubled. Travel fees may be negotiated for invitational and region tournaments, but are otherwise non-negotiable. Travel fees for State Tournament are a "flat fee" of \$25.00 per official per assignment.
