School Association (GHSA). "Being chosen by their respective regions for this honor is a testament to the exemplary conduct of these member schools. Embracing the principles of good

sportsmanship is essential in guiding our youth to become responsible and productive adults. The GHSA commends these schools for their achievement and extends gratitude to Georgia's Electric Membership Cooperatives (EMCs) for their unwavering support of this distinguished recognition program."

Since 2006, the GHSA and Georgia's EMCs have sponsored the Cooperative Spirit Sportsmanship Award which reinforces the GHSA philosophy: "Students, athletes, coaches, spectators and all others associated with high school activities programs should adhere to the fundamental values of respect, fairness, honesty and responsibility."
