# **ATTENTION: Basketball Coaches**

Two items need to be addressed before the season goes any further:

<u>OFFICIAL SCOREKEEPER</u>: The "official scorekeeper" who keeps the book at games **MUST** wear a black/white striped officials shirt for all Georgia High School Association sanctioned basketball games.

<u>SPORTSMANSHIP STATEMENT</u>: The official GHSA Sportsmanship Statement **MUST** be read prior to every GHSA contest or game. (The Sportsmanship Statement is reprinted to the right for your use.)

These two items are NOT optional, so please see to it that your school complies. Thank you.

### GHSA SPORTSMANSHIP STATEMENT

Please insure that the following statement is read as a public address announcement prior to the start of **every GHSA sanctioned contest**:

"The GHSA and its member schools have made a commitment to promote good sportsmanship by student/athletes, coaches, and spectators at all GHSA sanctioned events. Profanity, degrading remarks, and intimidating actions directed at officials or competitors will not be tolerated, and are grounds for removal from the event site. Spectators are not allowed to enter the competition area during warm-ups or while the contest is being conducted. Thank you for your cooperation in the promotion of good sportsmanship at today's event."

# **GHSA Officials / Coaches Clinics**

By-Law #2.54, page 32 of the GHSA Constitution and By-Laws states: Every coach at a GHSA member school must attend a GHSA-sponsored rules clinic if he/she coaches the following sports: football, softball, volleyball, riflery, cheerleading (spirit and/or competitive), basketball, wrestling, swimming and diving, track, baseball, soccer and gymnastics.

- (a) A \$50.00 fine per coach who does not attend a clinic will be assessed to the school.
- (b) First-year community coaches are reminded that clinic attendance is mandatory for them, also.

Following is a listing of the remaining 2006-07 GHSA Rules Clinics for coaches and officials. Weeknight clinics begin at 7:30 p.m. Saturday clinics begin at 10 a.m. unless noted. ATTENDANCE IS REQUIRED.

NOTE: All BASKETBALL, CHEERLEADING, FOOTBALL, GYMNAS-TICS, RIFLERY, SOFTBALL, SWIMMING, VOLLEYBALL and WRES-TLING clinics have been completed.






