State Championship Football Broadcast Schedules Set

The Georgia High School Association State Football Championship games will be televised live on Georgia Public Broadcasting, video streamed on GPB.org/football (GHSA.tv) and carried on the radio at 680 The Fan, Atlanta's Sports Station, and their family of stations.

The schedule for the games is as follows: Friday, December 11th — Class AA final at 4:30 p.m., Class AAAA final at 8:00 p.m.; Saturday, December 12th — Class A final at 1:00 p.m., Class AAAA final at 4:30 p.m., Class AAAAA final at 8:00 p.m.

The games will be available on demand at GHSA.tv (online) and rebroadcast on GPB Knowledge (tv) on Atlanta Comcast channel 246 or statewide on over the air service at .3 digital channel

The rebroadcast schedule will be in ascending order with the Class A championship on Monday and progress through to the Class AAAAA final on Friday with all games at 8:00 p.m. DVDs will be available for purchase at GHSA.tv.

Georgia Dome ticket prices each day are \$15 presale at the participating schools, or \$20 each day at the gate and through Ticketmaster.









