2013 GHSA-Tommy Guillebeau Football Championships

Once again, GPB will Telecast All Games Live from GA Dome

As with last year's inaugural GHSA-Tommy Guillebeau Football Championships presented by Georgia Farm Bureau, Georgia Public Broadcasting will televise live all seven of the state final football games from the Georgia Dome.

GPB's coverage will begin at 2:30 on Friday, December 13 with the Class A private school championship game. Longtime high school football voice

To m m y along with long time high school football voice Palmer will call the game along with high school coach Sam Barrs.

Game number two on Friday will be the Class AAA game. Jon Nelson of GPB and former Georgia Bulldog Kelin Johnson will do the play by play. And the third and final game of day one will be the Class AAAAA championship game with GPB's Trey McDaniel and WGCL-TV's Larry Smith behind the microphones.

On Saturday, December 14, four teams will win state titles. Up first at 11:30 a.m., is the Class A public school title with Tommy Palmer and Larry Smith calling the action. At 2:30 p.m., it's the Class AA game with former Falcon Chuck Smith in the broadcast booth.

At 5:30 it's the Class AAAA title game with Jon Nelson and Kelin Johnson again. And at 8:30, the AAAAAA final, with Trey McDaniel and Gil Tyree calling the game.

Mark Harmon and Claire Simms will host all the pregame and postgame shows, which will feature interviews with coaches, players, trophy presentations, along with performances from some of the marching bands as well as interviews with Principals and other special guests.



All games will be televised live throughout the state of Georgia and into parts of Florida, Alabama and Tennessee on Georgia Public Broadcasting and webcast live at GPB.org/sports and NFHSNetwork.com/GHSA.

GPB has nine television stations across Georgia and is in more than 98 percent of the homes in the state. GPB is the third largest PBS station in the country based on population reach and has been the most watched public station in the country on the days of the football championship broadcasts.

DVD orders of the championship games will be available at NFHSNetwork.com/GHSA. 




