

2017 GHSA-Tommy Guillebeau Football Championships

All Games Live on Dec. 8 & 9 From Mercedes-Benz Stadium

The sixth annual GHSA-Tommy Guillebeau Football Championships, presented by Georgia Farm Bureau Insurance, will again be televised live by Georgia Public Broadcasting this year from the new Mercedes-Benz Stadium.

GPB's coverage will begin at 10:00 a.m., on Friday, December 8 with the Class A private s c h o o l game. The lineup for the remainder of the day includes the game at 1:00 p.m., followed by the Class 5A game at 4:30 p.m., and the Class 6A game at 8 p.m.

On Saturday, December 9, four more teams will win state titles. Up first at 10:00 a.m., is the Class A public school title. At 1:00 p.m., it's the Class 2A game. At 4:30 p.m., it's the 4A title game. And at 8:00, the 7A final.

This year's on-air talent for GPB's coverage includes hosts Mark Harmon and Nikky Williams, and Jon Nelson, Tommy Palmer, Matt Stewart, Sam Crenshaw (sidelines), Larry Smith, Paul Crane and Hannah Chalker (sidelines). Chelsea Tofoya will serve as the Social Media correspondent.



All games will be televised live throughout the state of Georgia and into parts of Florida, Alabama and Tennessee on Georgia Public Broadcasting and webcast live at GPB.org/sports and NFHSNetwork.com/GHSA.

GPB has nine television stations across Georgia and is in more than 98 percent of the homes in the state. GPB is the third largest PBS station in the country based on population reach and has been the most watched public station in the country on the days of the football championship broadcasts.


