Reminders of Changes in the Reclassification Process

Incredibly, it is just about time to reclassify member schools for the 2008-2010 cycle. This work will begin in late spring and will be finalized in January of 2008.

The reclassification process has been changed over the past year, so it is important to refresh our collective memories about those changes. In March (2006) and August (2006), constitutional amendments passed two votes of the Executive Committee, and that also changed the procedures in By-Law 4.16.

Since the final vote occurred after the printing of the 2006-07 GHSA Constitution and By-laws, this information can only be found in the minutes of the past two Executive Committee meetings.



Reclassification for public schools will be based on an average of the FTE counts provided by the Georgia Department of Education for the spring semester (2007) and the fall semester (2007). This means that the communications to the membership and appeals processes will be compacted into a timeframe beginning in late-October to ending in mid-January.

It is believed that this change will provide more accurate information about member schools whose populations are changing so rapidly. Private schools will be reclassified on their actual FTE counts at the beginning of the 2007-08 school year.

Shortly after the fall count is released by the Department of Education, the classifications will be established and sent to schools for review (probably in early November) and schools will have two weeks to file their requests to play at a higher classification.

As soon as the classifications are set, the Reclassification Committee will meet to place the schools in each classification into regions and sub-regions. When this has been completed, schools will be notified and will have two weeks to appeal for lateral transfers (probably in mid-December). The final reclassification placements will be ratified by the Executive Committee at a specially called meeting in January of 2008.

Qualifying Standards - Diving

A diver may become eligible for the State Meet using a 6dive sheet or an 11-dive sheet.

- 1) 6-DIVE: The degree of difficulty of dives 2-6 when totaled shall be equal to or more than 10.4 for both boys and girls. The score to be achieved must be 200 points or more.
- 2) 11-DIVE: The minimum degree of difficulty for optional dives shall be 11.5 for girls and 12.0 for boys. The score to be achieved for both boys and girls is 270 points or more.
