More Exciting Things To Come During Spring Seasons

As January of 2017 comes to a close, the winter sports trimester in the Georgia High School Association's 2016-2017 school year begins to close out as well. Within the next few weeks, we will see champions proclaimed in wrestling and swimming. In early March, 17 basketball champions will be crowned. Already we have celebrated champions in fastpitch softball, cross country, one-act play, team dual wrestling, cheerleading, volleyball and, of course, football.

On December 10, 2016, the last high school football game ended the Georgia High School Association run in the Georgia Dome with the Class 7A championship – our newest classification. Other levels of football – college and professional – kept the games going in the Dome until the Atlanta Falcons "closed the football doors" on Sunday, January 22, 2017, by winning the NFC Championship.



The Georgia High School Association experienced record crowds at our football finals and we celebrated the past champions with special football presentations at halftimes and between games.

In the end, we were saddened to be leaving such a fine site for our championships. We commend the Georgia Dome leadership and their entire staff. They have been great hosts over the many years the Georgia High School Association has played there. Many fond memories for thousands of high school athletes and fans were created in the Dome. What a great job by everyone there!

The finals in Swimming and Diving return to the pool on the Georgia Tech campus for another thrilling three days of championship competitions (Feb. 2-4). Again many, many students will compete in this top rated facility. Several changes in the events protocols should make the competition even more exciting, while shortening the overall hours of competition. We look forward to the opportunity to experience this increased excitement and one-of-a-kind experiences for our athletes.

Wrestling will crown its end-of-season Traditional Tournament champions on February 11 at the Centreplex in Macon. The Team Dual championships earlier in January saw the return of several programs to the top of their classification tournaments. New champions were celebrated just as were repeat champions, as well as schools appearing in the championship brackets for the very first time. We anticipate continued excitement as more than 1,500 athletes compete for individual and team honors in Macon.

The beginning of the Spring seasons (Trimester) will feature brand new site locations for track, baseball, soccer, gymnastics and lacrosse. All GHSA fans should stay tuned – the fun, the enthusiasm and the thrills will continue.

Lacrosse Finals to be Held at Lakewood

Atlanta's Lakewood Stadium will be the site for all the 2017 Lacrosse state championships. The Class A-5A boys and girls title games will take place on Saturday, May 13. while the finals for boys and girls in Class 6A-7A will be played on Saturday, May 20.

Jasper Jewell, Athletic Director for the Atlanta Public School System, was instrumental in helping bring the Lacrosse championships to Lakewood Stadium, which underwent a \$17 million renovation in 2012.

Lakewood, the largest stadium in the APS, now features new locker rooms, spectator seating, lights and artificial turf (lined for both boys and girls lacrosse), and the GHSA is excited about using this fine facility to showcase high school lacrosse.

Swimming and Wrestling Live Streamed

State Championship action of the Swimming and Diving, and the Traditional Wrestling State Championships will be video streamed live on the NFHS Network (nfhsnetwork.com/associations/ghsa).

The cost is one low price of \$9.95 to watch unlimited events for 30 days, which also could include select basketball playoff games.

The Swimming & Diving State Finals will be live from Georgia Tech Aquatic Center. Schedule: Thursday, Feb. 2 from 9:00 am - 1:00 pm (6A-7A Diving) and 3:00 - 7:00 pm (1A-5A Diving); Saturday, Feb. 4 from 1:00 to 4:30 p.m. (6A-7A Swimming)) and 6:00 to 9:00 p.m., (1A-5A Swimming).

A week later, the Traditional Wrestling State Finals, presented by the Georgia Army National Guard, will be broadcast from the Macon Coliseum with live action from all seven championship mats on Saturday, Feb. 11 beginning at 3:00 p.m. Schedules for both events can be found on the GHSA.net web and on Page 6 of this newsletter.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE ITEMS: Anyone wishing to have an item included on the agenda for the spring State Executive Committee meeting must submit the item to the GHSA office by March 10, 2017. The spring State Executive Committee meeting will be held April 10, 2017 at the Marriott Macon City Center.

FOOTBALL SCHEDULES: Coaches and/or Athletic Directors are reminded that 2017 varsity Football Schedules are due in the GHSA office no later than March 1, 2017. If your school has hired a new coach for the 2017 season, please make sure he is made aware of this deadline.

OPEN MEET DEADLINE: Member schools are reminded of the deadline to notify the GHSA of entry in Open Meet State Events such as Volleyball, Lacrosse, Class A Soccer, Wrestling, Riflery and Gymnastics for the school year 2017-2018. The deadline for notification is April 1, 2017.

SPRING CHEERLEADING TRYOUTS: Cheerleading practice/tryouts are limited to a maximum of 10 consecutive days per school between February 1 and the last day students are in school. Once tryouts are complete, no further practices may be held until school is out.

DEAD WEEK: The mandatory "Dead Week" for this year is Sunday, July 2, 2017 through Saturday, July 8, 2017.

State Swimming and Diving Meets

The 2017 **State Swimming and Diving Championships** will be held on February 2-4 at the Georgia Tech Campus Recreation Center in Atlanta. Admission is \$12 per day.

Free admission will be allowed for the following: 1. Swimmers and divers qualified and entered in the State Meet; 2. Coaches that are listed on the Swimming and Diving Coaches list; 3. Four girls and four boys designated as substitutes by the coach on the team list; 4. Two team attendants or trainers as listed on the team roster; 5. Those normally allowed free admission, such as GHSA passes, will continue to be admitted by signing the pass list.

Qualifying Standards - Diving

A diver may become eligible for the State Meet using a 6-dive sheet or an 11-dive sheet.

- 1) 6-DIVE: The degree of difficulty of dives 2-6 when totaled shall be equal to or more than 10.4 for both boys and girls. The score to be achieved must be 200 points or more.
- 2) 11-DIVE: The minimum degree of difficulty for optional dives shall be 11.5 for girls and 12.0 for boys. The score to be achieved for both boys and girls is 270 points or more.

Sectional Traditional Wrestling Tournaments will be held on Friday and/or Saturday, February 3-4, 2017.

The Traditional Wrestling Finals, presented by the Georgia Army National Guard, will be held on Thursday through Saturday, February 9-11, 2017 at the Macon Centreplex. Tickets for the State Finals are \$7 Thursday and \$10 on Friday and Saturday (all day), or a total tournament ticket will be sold for \$24.
