Levels & Benefits

PROGRAM LEVELS AVAILABLE AND FEE SCHEDULE:

LEVEL 1: \$10 PER OFFICIAL

Includes access to educational components only.

LEVEL 2: \$17 PER OFFICIAL

Includes access to educational components and insurance coverage for each member of the association.

LEVEL 3: \$20 PER OFFICIAL

Includes access to educational components and NFHS Network Membership for every official (no insurance).

LEVEL 4: \$25 PER OFFICIAL

Includes access to educational components, insurance, and NFHS Network Membership for every official.

Benefits for State Associations in the NFHS Officials Education Services Program:

EXAMS:

Unlimited number of FREE electronic NFHS sport rules (Part I and Part II) for officials on the NFHS Exam Center. Features include:

- Ability to customize testing features such as: number of questions, randomized question order, testing date range, adding state-specific questions, number of "takes" permitted, how/when test-taker sees results.

- Technical support to officials on testing platform.
- States that have developed their own testing platform or want to print and distribute the tests on their own, will be provided an electronic version of the NFHS exam.

NOTE: States that have not opted into the education services program are charged \$1.00 for each individual test-taker on the NFHS platform or \$500 for each electronic version of an NFHS exam.

SPORT RULES POWER POINTS AND RULES CHANGE VIDEOS:

Electronic versions of the PowerPoint, as well as the rules change videos, are accessible for FREE in a secured area of the NFHS Web site (MyGroups).

NOTE: States that have not opted into the education services program are charged \$100 per sport PowerPoint and \$100 per sport rules change videos.

ONLINE RULE INTERPRETER'S MEETINGS:

FREE access for unlimited connections to each sport's online rule interpreter's meetings. **NOTE:** States that have not opted into the education services program are charged \$100 for each online connection.

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Benefits For Individual Officials NFHS Officials Education Services Program State Associations:

INSURANCE COVERAGE:

Insurance coverage includes:

- Coverage for all levels of officiating (youth, recreational, adult and collegiate) in sports recognized by the state high school association.
- Excess General Liability
 - \$2,000,000 per occurrence limit
 - \$5,000,000 aggregate limit
- Excess Accident Medical
 - \$50,000 accident medical/dental limit per injury
 - \$250 deductible per injury
 - \$2,000 limit for physical therapy and chiropractic treatment
 - \$2,500 accidental death & dismemberment benefit
- **NOTE:** Insurance coverage is from July 1st through June 30th, regardless of date of registration.

ACCESS TO NFHS DIGITAL RULEBOOKS:

Individual officials receive complimentary access to digital publications (with the state association's purchase of printed publications; one digital license per each book purchased). Digital publications included in this offering are rules books (all sports), case books (baseball, basketball, football, softball, track & field, volleyball, and wrestling), handbooks (basketball and football), and officials' manuals (baseball, basketball, football, soccer, softball, and volleyball)

AWARDS PROGRAM:

First-class national awards and recognition program acknowledging officials at the state, sectional and national levels.

NFHS COMMITTEES:

Representation on NFHS sport rules committees and standing committees. Nominations are submitted to the NFHS by the official's state high school association.

NFHS NETWORK SUBSCRIPTION:

Officials in Level 3 or Level 4 states will receive an annual subscription to the NFHS Network, providing them an opportunity to access unlimited games for their educational purposes. The normal annual value of an NFHS subscription is \$79.99 per individual and will now be included at a heavily discounted rate for Level 3 or Level 4 states.

OTHER BENEFITS:

Officials in states that have opted into the NFHS Officials Education Services Program also receive discounts on rental cars through National and Enterprise and discounts through Signature Championship Rings.
