

FIRST-TIME CHAMPS WILL BE TRENDING THIS WEEKEND AT MERCER BY GRAHAM DAVID

The Whitewater and St. Vincent's girls represent the only teams of the 16 participants taking the field at Mercer University this weekend that will be defending 2018 state titles. Also included in the field of teams are five boys and four girls squads that are on the hunt for their program's first state soccer titles.

Both McIntosh Chiefs teams also advanced to the Class AAAAA finals a year ago with a chance to give both programs consecutive titles. Neither teams, however, were able to walk away victorious with the boys falling to Johnson-Gainesville and the girls losing to Whitewater in penalties. This year, the boys will be facing off against a strong Starr's Mill team that dealt them a 1-0 loss during the regular season. The Lady Chiefs will be paired up against the Whitewater Wildcats, a team they bested 3-0 early this season. Starr's Mill has won a pair of boys state titles in the past, both coming in the Class AAA and AAAA finals. A victory against McIntosh would give the Panthers their first title since 2010. Whitewater's matchup against the Lady Chiefs is a rematch from last year's finals, and the Wildcats are poised to avenge their regular season loss to McIntosh and defend their title. Whitewater used a 2-1 overtime victory against Carrollton in Tuesday's semifinals to keep its season alive.

EYE ON THE PRIZE

In Class AAAA, the matchup between the Upson-Lee and Oconee County boys will end with one of the schools claiming its first title in school history. Upson-Lee came close to their first title last year, but were shutout and defeated by Chestatee in the semifinals. This season, the Knights finished their regular season without dropping a single loss and have yet to sacrifice a goal during the postseason. After a 5-1 victory over Sandy Creek in the first round, Oconee County has won each of its postseason games by one goal, including a tense double-overtime game against Southeast Whitfield. The St. Pius X girls are returning to the Class AAAA finals for a chance to grab their eighth title in 10 years and 12th in school history. Looking to deny them that opportunity will be Flowery Branch, a team that took St. Pius X to penalties in the regular season, but ultimately fell after being outshot 4-2.

The Union County Panthers enter the boys Class AA finals looking for their first state title in school history and are coming off two shutout victories in the guarterfinals and semifinals. The Thomasville Bulldogs won their first state title in 2010, and are coming off a stellar 6-1 win over Putnam County in the semifinals as they aim to deny Union County their shot at school history. The St. Vincent's girls are one win away from completing their three-peat in Class AA, and have not given up a single goal during their postseason run. Vidalia was ousted in the second round of last year's playoffs with a 1-0 loss to Harlem, but this year's one-loss Indians team is on a roll and coming off a 2-1 win over Model in the semifinals, that kept their postseason run alive.

Class A was divided into Class A-Private and Class A-Public championships for the first time this season, and as a result, all four of the participating schools on the Class A-Public side are a win away from clinching first-ever state titles.. The Lake Oconee boys were matched up against finals opponent Georgia Military College earlier in the season and lost 2-1 in overtime to the Bulldogs. The ACE Charter and Atlanta Classical girls have each tallied 13 goals through their three rounds of post-season victories.


