

The Sectional date for all 5A Classification will be November 1, 2025.

The meet links and registration have been created on MileSplit GA. This year, team rosters will be expanded to 14 athletes. Junior Varsity (JV) races will be permitted; however, they will only take place after all varsity qualifying races have been completed. As indicated in the schedule below, all qualifying races will conclude before any additional events begin. *The second set of races must include the remaining seven runners from your varsity roster.* All other runners will compete in the JV races and will not be eligible varsity participants. Timers should ensure that JV and varsity results are recorded separately in MileSplit.

- All teams, buses, and spectators will use the same entrance.

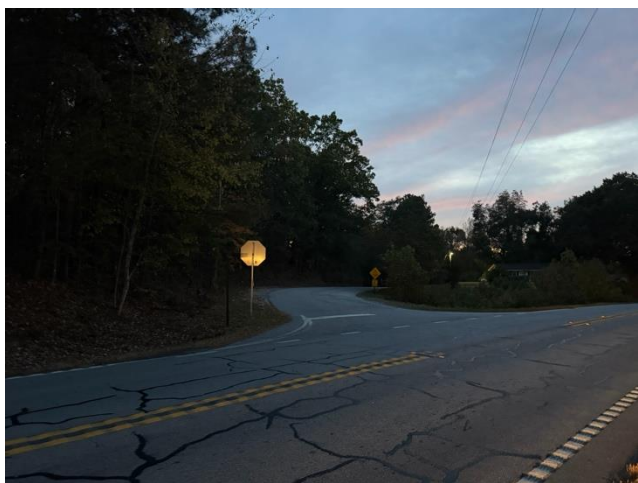
